CALL FOR INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE FACILITATORS

Recently Human Rights and Human Rights Education (HRE) in the youth field are gaining importance in European political agendas. When it comes to the values and principles of youth work practice, it however remains unclear to what extent today's youth work practice consistently stems from a culture of Human Rights at its core, and to what extent youth workers see themselves as carriers of values of Human Rights.

The Human Rights Education conference aims to facilitate awareness of youth work practice and potential of youth sector for mainstreaming HRE. The conference is a final event of the Erasmus+ Key Action 3 project "Youth for Human Rights (YfHR)" (2016-2019) which aims to foster social inclusion through making use of the full potential of youth work and of HRE in the context of youth work and young people's non-formal learning.

As a result of the discussions at the conference we aim to shed light in the present and in the future of HRE. The results of the conference will be conveyed as policy recommendations to responsible bodies of the Erasmus+ programme and further be taken on board in youth policy development.

The conference brings together Erasmus+ National Agencies (NA's), local authorities, European institutions, NGO's, human rights education experts, trainers, and many more stakeholders in order to share and build upon the results of 'Youth for Human Rights' project. The conference is open to all NA's through Training and Cooperation Activities (TCA) means. It is a place for stakeholders gathering on the topic of youth policy recommendations, as well as space for sharing space for best practices on HRE. The event will consist of workshops and discussions.

Target group of the Conference: up to 100-150 stakeholders will be invited to the Conference.

The Conference will take place on October 29th-30th, 2019 in Tallinn Estonia.

- ✓ very good level of spoken and written English;
- ✓ good knowledge and demonstrated experience in the youth field at various levels, in particular in the Youth chapter of the Erasmus+ programme;
- ✓ good understanding on HRE and its link to youth work and youth policy;
- ✓ experience in working as a facilitator or a moderator in international events organized by NAs or SALTO Resource Centres.

Selected facilitators are expected to:

- ✓ actively participate in the preparation and facilitation of the conference (including attendance to the meeting with the Leading NA in Estonia)
- ✓ to develop the conference methodology according to the concept and aims and objectives as identified by the preparatory group of the YfHR consortium
- ✓ to prepare the invitation and call for participants that triggers interest;
- ✓ to structure the programme of the conference and facilitate the sessions;
- ✓ to develop and coordinate the script, to brief speakers and make sure they are prepared for the event
- ✓ to take part in the evaluation of the conference;
- ✓ capturing the main content and messages of the conference in written form (final report)

Facilitator's fee

Both facilitators will get a fee 290 EUR per day (including preparation and evaluation days). The fee includes participation in the preparatory meeting, preparation, implementation and evaluation of the conference. International travel costs will be reimbursed separately. Board and lodging during the prep. meeting (if needed) and the conference will be covered by the organisers. In case additional preparatory or follow-up measures are agreed, additional fees will be agreed upon.

Application procedure & deadline

Interested candidates should send their motivation letter which also demonstrates their experiences and their CV or a link to SALTO trainers or other online profile/portfolio **in English by March 29th, 2019. In the proposal, the applicants need to provide a calculation of total fee and of days.** Applicants will be informed about the selection results in April 2019.
