ACTIVITIES

Gathering and mapping human rights education state of play, key actors, concepts and resources in national and international context.

OUTCOME

- 8 national mapping reports.
- 1 synthesis report of national mappings.
- 1 transnational/European mapping report.

TRAINING MODULES

ACTIVITIES

Adapting and developing HRE training and educational modules and concepts, overviewing HRE resources.

OUTCOME

- Expert group develops HRE training modules for Training of Trainers, training of youth leaders/workers, Erasmus+ NA's staff training.
- Expert group develops recommendations for integrating HRE to formal preparation of youth workers through national transfer seminars.

CAPACITY BUILDING

ACTIVITIES

Capacity building of actors in the youth field on HRE and support to thematic network development.

OUTCOME

- 28 trainers-of-trainers trained on HRE in the field of youth.
- 280 youth leaders/workers trained on HRE in the field of youth.
- 22 Erasmus+ NAs staff trained on HRE in the field of youth.
- 1400 young people taking part in HRE activities.
- National and transnational networking activities on HRE.

UPSCALING & POLICY IMPACT

ACTIVITIES

Upscaling and exploiting project results.

OUTCOME

- 100 stakeholders participate in European conference Compilation of policy recommendations Evaluation.

- Improving understanding of HRE in the field of youth and supporting young people's acquisition of social, civic and intercultural competence.

- Improving and developing the quality of youth practice through networking and capacity-building.
